Mileage Program – Awards Form

Definition: The Mileage Program is designed to recognize those Registered Spanish Mustangs that travel over miles of distance and trails for pleasure or conditioning. These rides/drives may be solo or with other horses.

Rules:

- 1) Horses must be registered with the Spanish Mustang Registry, Inc. during the entire point season for which points are submitted. If more than one horse is ridden, make a sheet for each horse.
- 2) The owner of the horse must be an up-to-date member of the organization and any points earned during a period in which the owner is not a member will not be utilized in the compilation of points for the season.
- 3) The person named as the owner on the point form must be the person who is named as owner on the horse's registration per official SMR records.
- 4) Riders do not need to be members of the organization.
- 5) Documentation of mileage may be in the form of training logs or the official mileage form.
- 6) This category is based on the honor system since many miles are typically logged as solo miles.
- 7) Miles from CTR and Endurance rides are not included in this category since these activities have their own mileage accrual recognition. However training and conditioning miles for CTR and Endurance are accepted for recognition in this category. Other miles may be from pleasure riding or driving.
- 8) To convert hours ridden to miles, a 1 to 3 ratio is generally accepted as standard rate at a walk. (1 hour = 3 miles)
- 9) Mileage patches will be awarded at 500-mile intervals for riding and 250-mile intervals for driving.
- 10) Miles are accumulated over the lifetime of the horse.
- 11) Miles from the Compadre Category are automatically included in the mileage program.
- 12) Forms due to Points and Awards Coordinator by February 1<sup>st</sup>.
